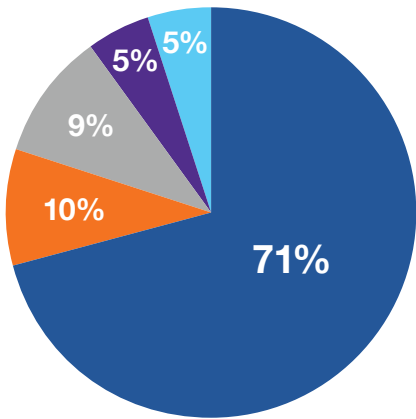

Note on Federal Individual Giving Limits:

- *Direct to JStreetPAC: You can give up to \$5,000 directly to the PAC per calendar year.*
- *To candidates endorsed by JStreetPAC: Under federal law, you can contribute a maximum of \$2,700 per election—primary, general, or runoff—to candidates for federal office.*

JStreetPAC is a federal Political Action Committee that helps elect pro-Israel, pro peace candidates to federal office, primarily by endorsing and raising money for their campaigns.

Gifts are NOT tax-deductible. 100% OF GIFTS GO DIRECTLY TO CAMPAIGNS.
