Position:

J Street is seeking an undergraduate or recent graduate to intern in our Israel office. The internship is an excellent opportunity to expand on organizing skills and to grow J Street's reach to students in Israel.

The Student Organizer Interns will be responsible for doing outreach to students in Israel, conducting 1:1 conversations and recruiting for Ta Shema trips. In addition to these responsibilities, interns will have the opportunity understand more deeply the reality on the ground in Israel/Palestine by learning from partner organizations and meeting with activists in the West Bank and in Israel.

Desired Skills and Experience:

Applicants should have:

- Community organizing experience
- An ability to work independently
- Knowledge of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict
- Commitment to J Street's mission

Excellent candidates may have:

- Experience organizing in J Street U
- Knowledge of Hebrew and/or Arabic

More about J Street:

J Street is the political home for pro-Israel, pro-peace Americans working to secure the future of Israel as the democratic homeland of the Jewish people. The organization believes that preserving Israel's Jewish and democratic character depends on achieving a two-state solution, resulting in a Palestinian state living alongside Israel in peace and security.

Launched in 2008 with four staff members and a limited budget, J Street is now a \$10 million organization with a national staff of 70. The organization is headquartered in Washington, DC, and employs staff in 9 cities including Boston, Chicago, Los Angeles, New York, the San Francisco Bay Area, and Tel Aviv.

J Street focuses its work in three main areas: (1) Advocating and demonstrating support for pro-Israel, pro-peace policies in Congress, the media and the Jewish community; (2) Endorsing and raising money for federal candidates who share J Street's agenda; and (3)

Educating the public and raising awareness of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and the two-state solution.

Compensation and Time Commitment:

This is an unpaid and full-time internship. Interns are responsible for airfare, finding their own accommodations and covering their living expenses in Israel for the duration of the internship. Applicants are encouraged to apply for highly subsidized internship programs, for example through [Onward Israel](#) in order to enhance their experience in Israel and minimize expenditures.
