Florida & Pennsylvania Jewish Survey Results

October 2020

Florida

- Conducted October 12-14, 2020
- 600 Jewish likely voters by landline and cell phone
- Margin of error: +/- 4.0 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence interval

Pennsylvania

- Conducted October 12-15, 2020
- 710 Jewish likely voters by landline, cell phone, and text-to-web
- Margin of error: +/- 3.7 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence interval

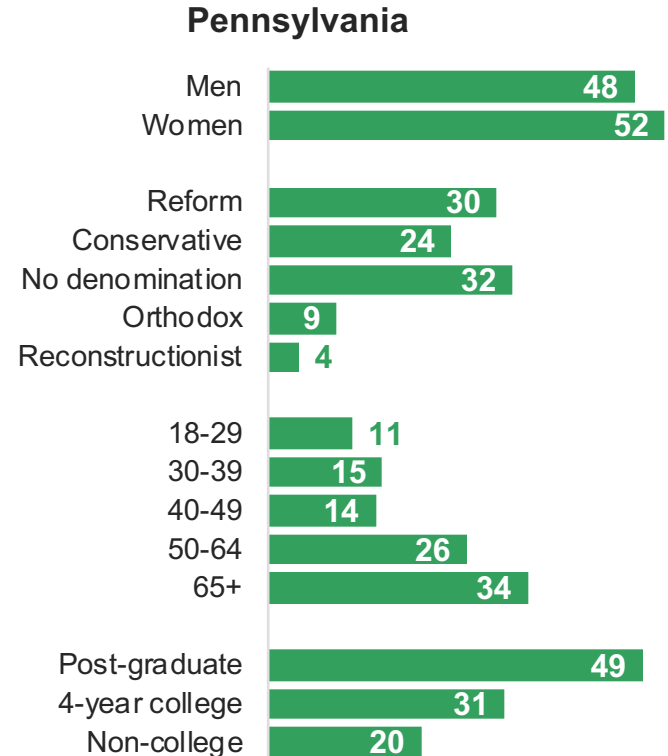
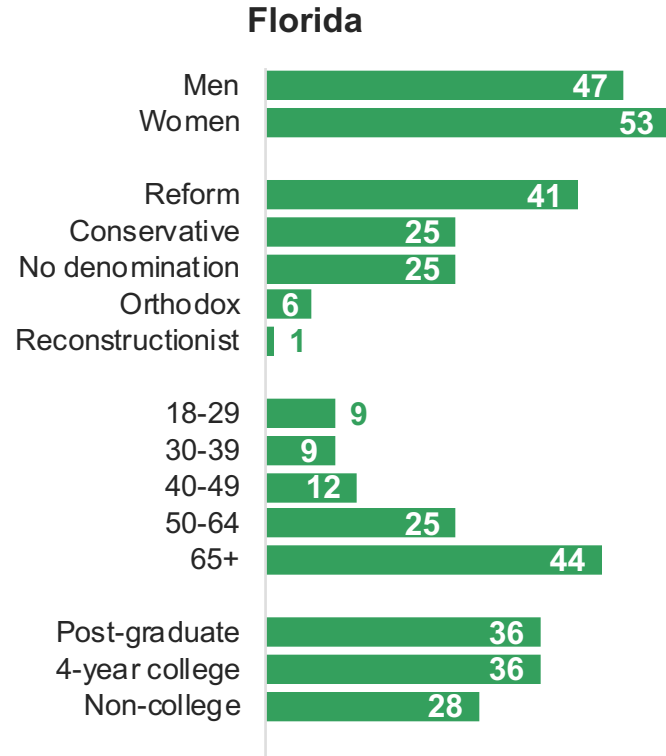
- Joe Biden enters the final two weeks of the election with massive leads over Donald Trump with Jewish voters in Florida and Pennsylvania.
 - Biden leads 73 to 22 percent in Florida.
 - Biden leads 75 to 22 percent in Pennsylvania.
 - Only one percent are undecided in each state.
- These two swing states show remarkable similarity among Jewish attitudes across a range of measures, including their issue priorities and which candidate does a better job on different issues.
 - The pandemic is, by far, the top issue in both states, followed by the economy and health care. Israel ranks toward the bottom of voters' priorities.
 - Biden holds major advantages on all issues, including central campaign themes such as the pandemic (+56 in FL; +56 in PA) and combatting white nationalism and anti-Semitism (+55 in FL; +54 in PA). Voters also see Biden as better at keeping American Jews safe (+42 in FL; +46 in PA).

- Large majorities of Jewish voters in both states support a two-state peace agreement between Israelis and Palestinians that includes recognized borders, Palestinian neighborhoods in Jerusalem becoming part of the new Palestinian state and Jewish neighborhoods remaining in Israel, and allows most Jewish settlers in the West Bank to be in Israel while the Palestinians receive comparable land areas in return.
 - Florida: 64 percent support/16 percent oppose/20 percent undecided.
 - Pennsylvania: 65 percent support/17 percent oppose/18 percent undecided.
- Nearly all Jews (89 percent in FL, 87 percent in PA) believe people can be both “pro-Israel” and critical of Israeli government policy.
- Florida and Pennsylvania Jewish voters express strong support for re-entering the Iran deal.
 - Florida: 64 percent support, including 40 percent strongly support.
 - Pennsylvania: 62 percent support, including 44 percent strongly support.

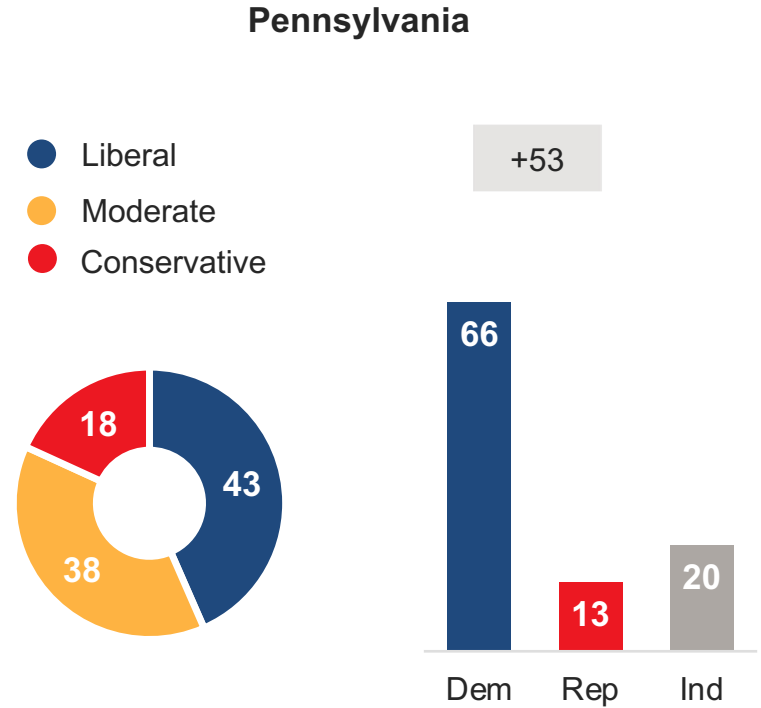
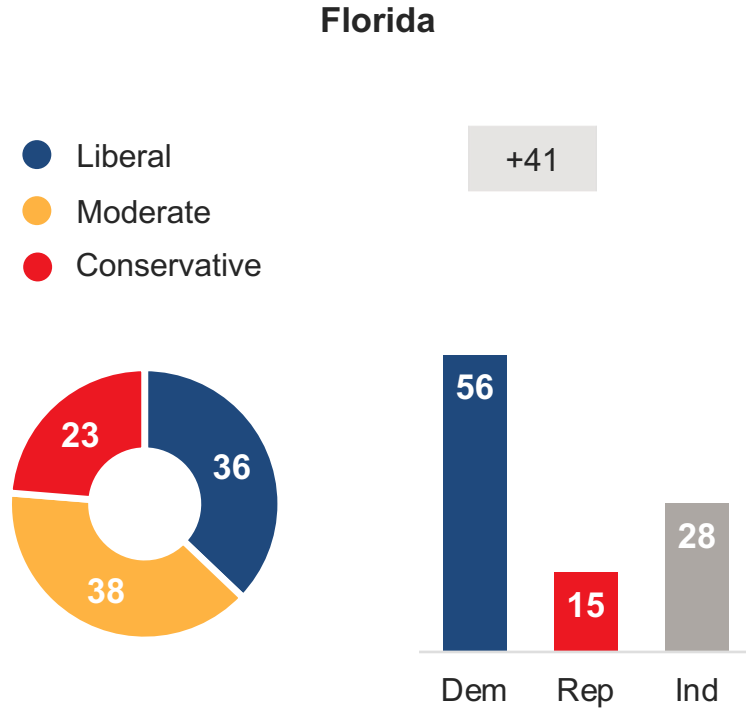
Demographics

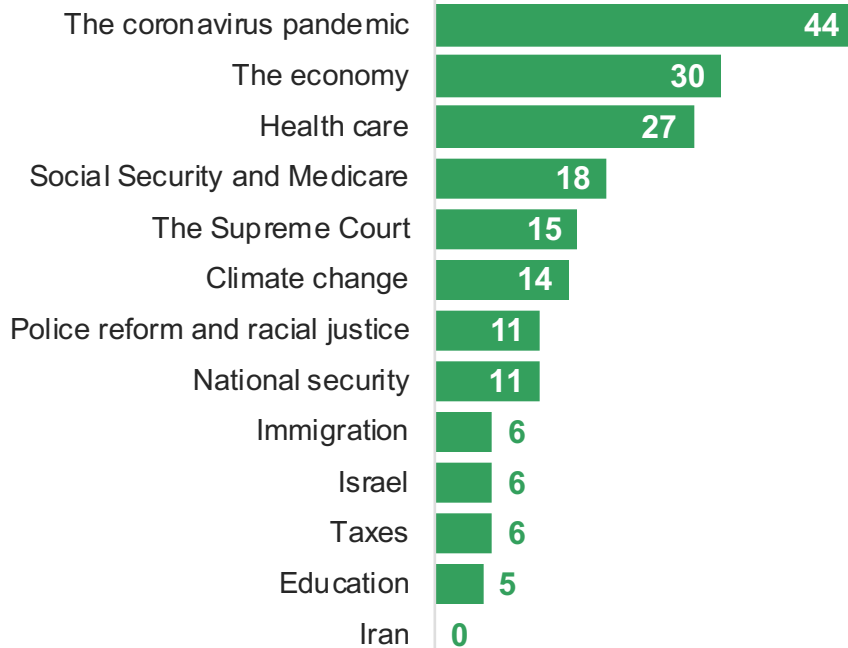

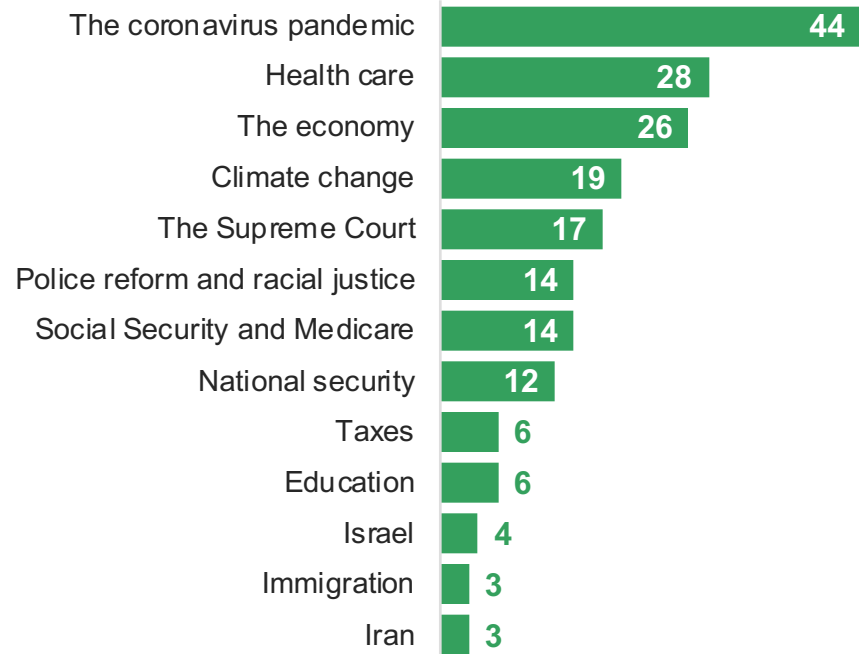

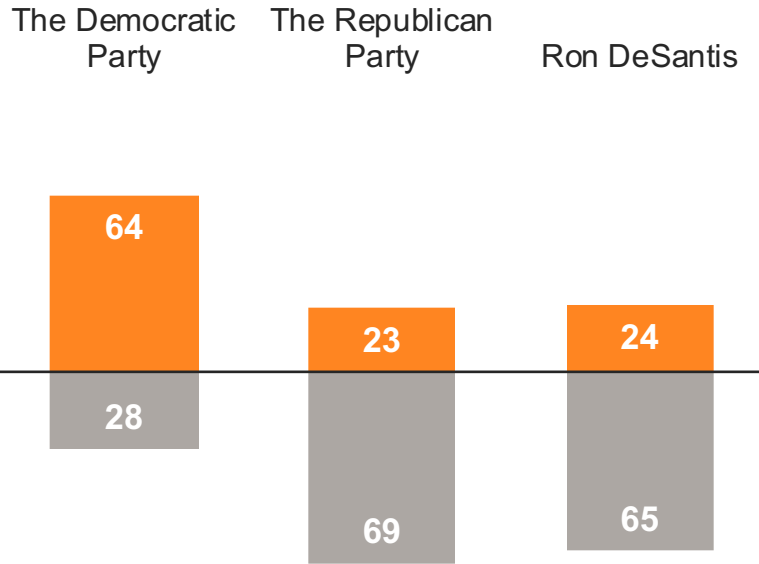
Republican Party Is Severely Damaged; Strong Support For Democrats

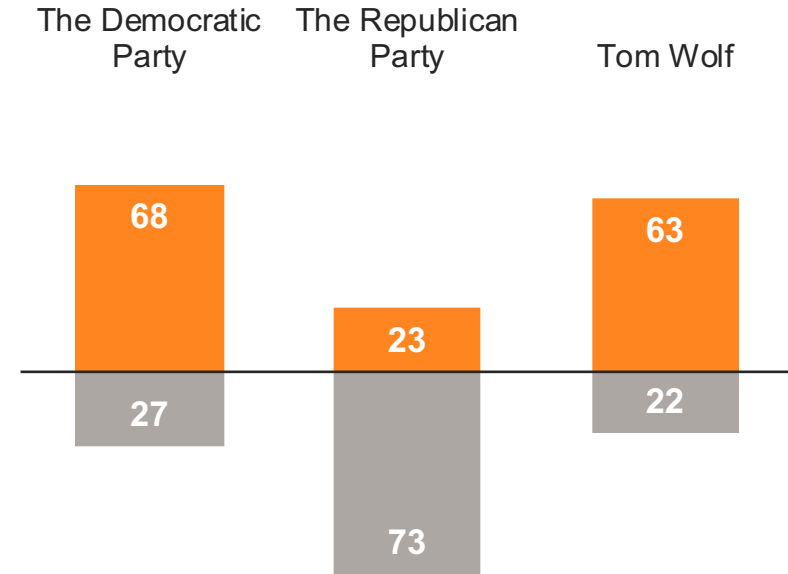

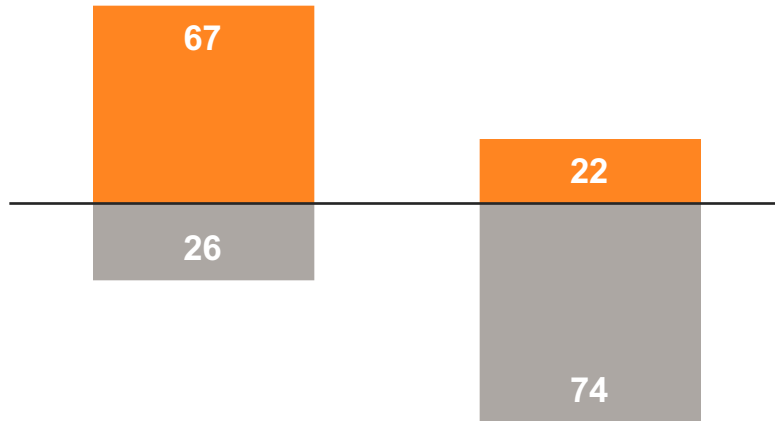

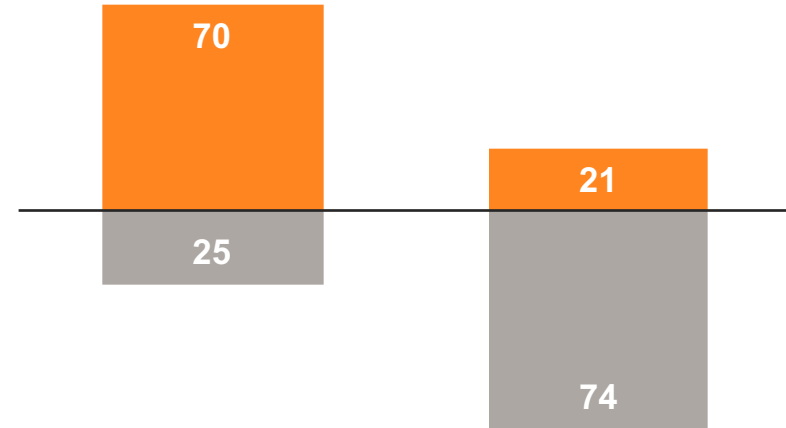

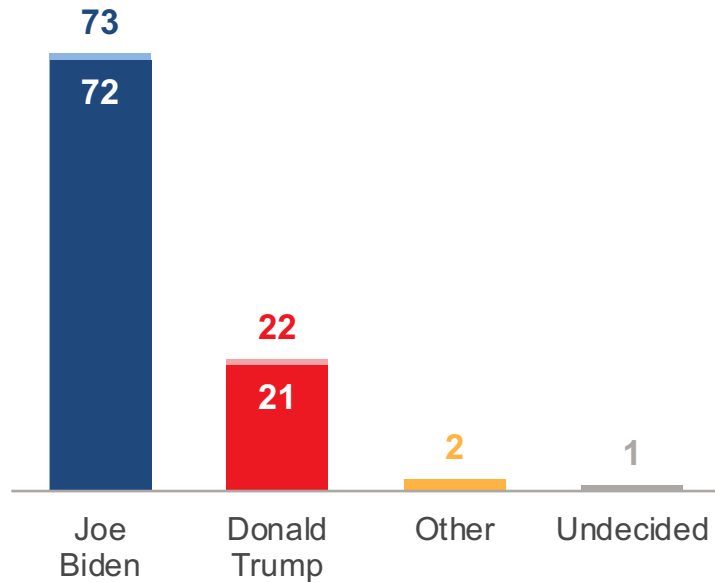


Vote Nearly Identical Across Both States; Minimal Persuasion Remains

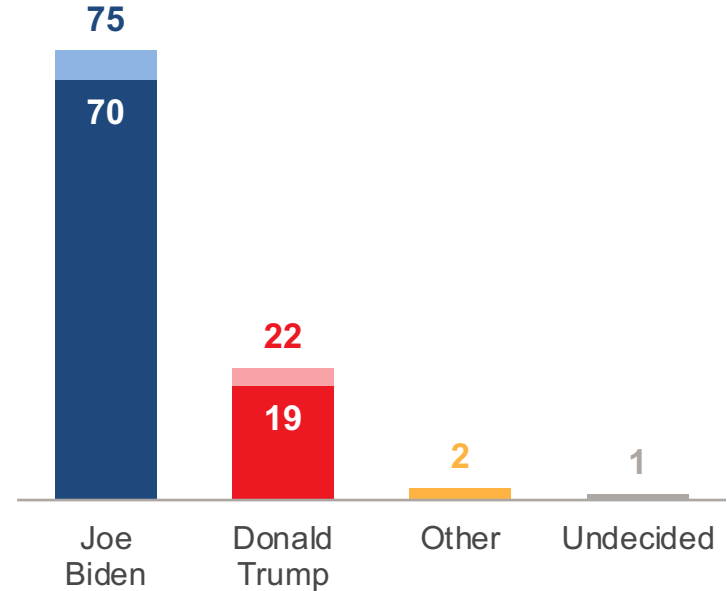

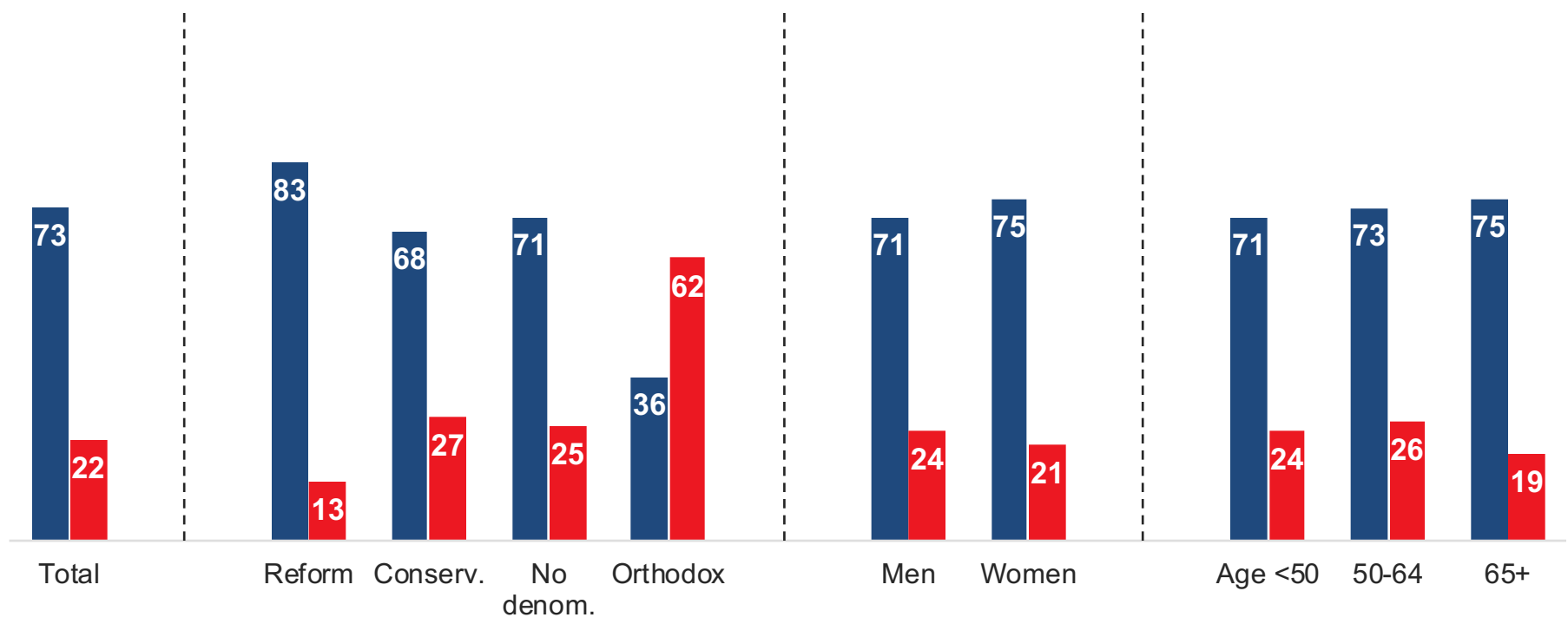


Biden Leads Across Electorate In FL, Except Among Orthodox

● Biden ● Trump

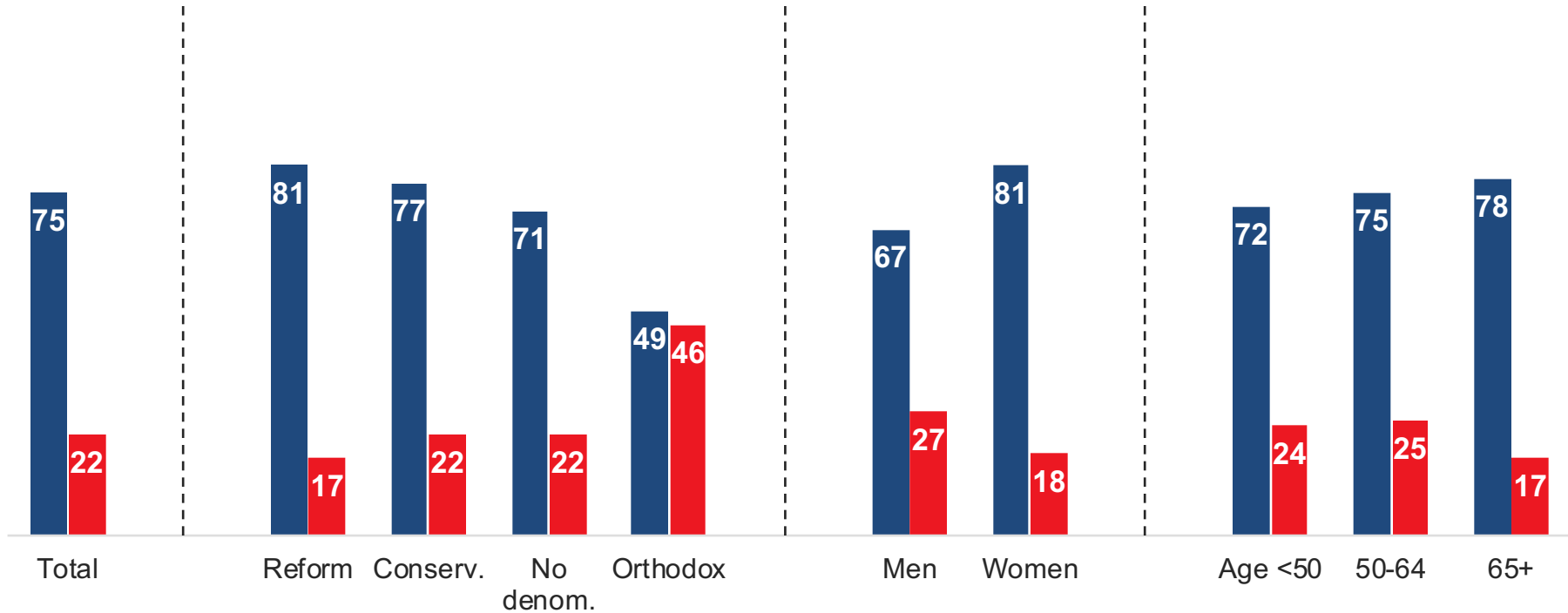


Biden Lead In PA Is Very Broad

● Biden ● Trump

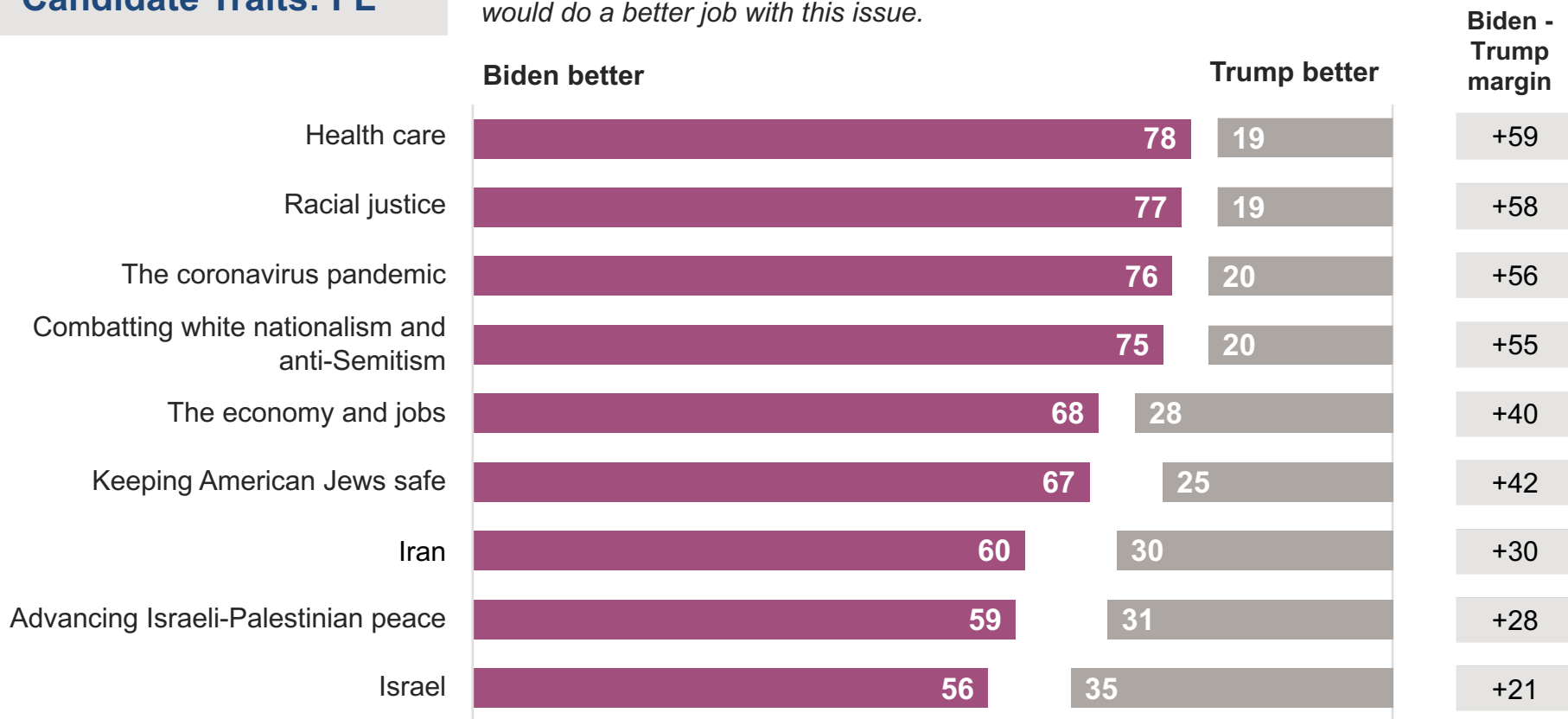


Biden Holds Massive Advantages Across Issues In FL, Especially Issues Central To National Debate

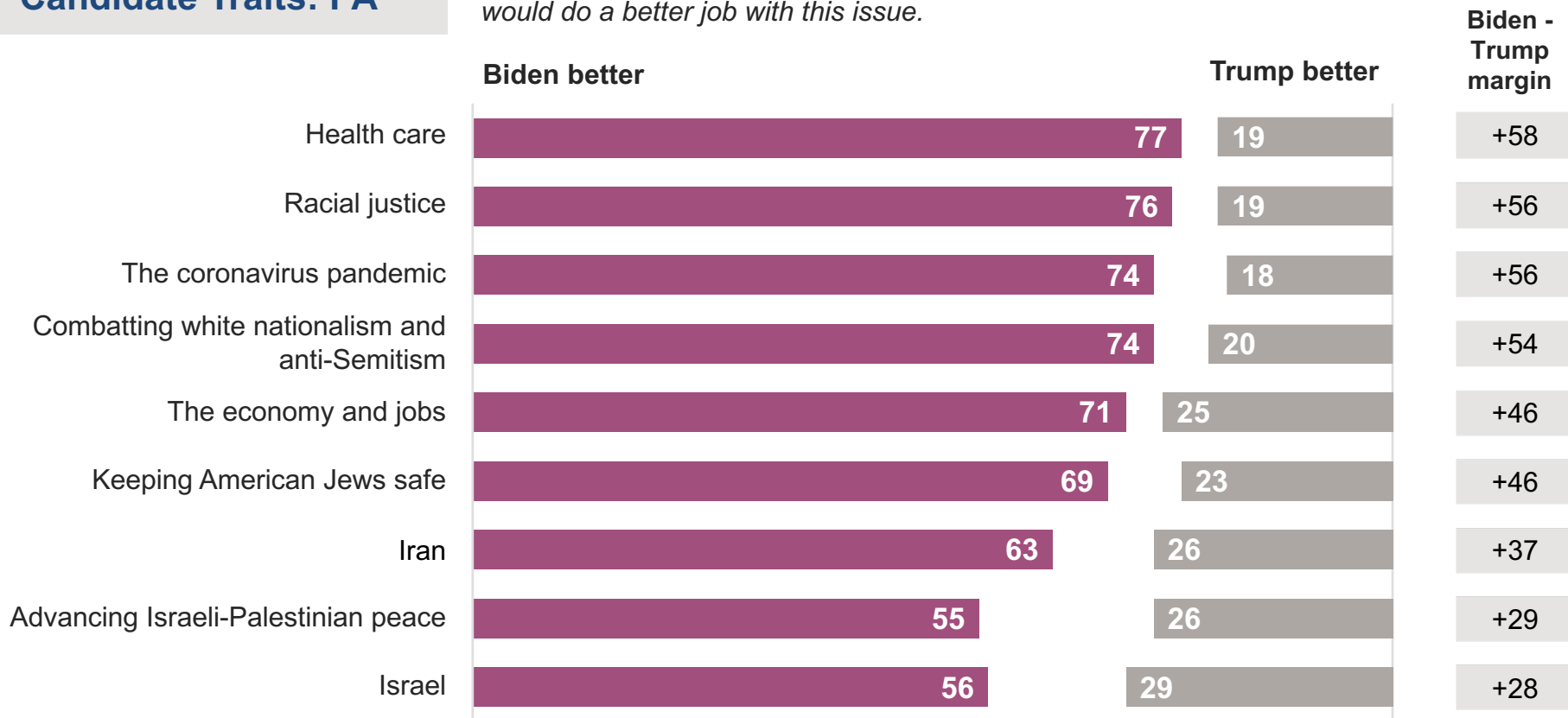


Biden Issue Advantage Has Same Results In PA As In FL

For each of the issues, please tell me whether you think Joe Biden or Donald Trump would do a better job with this issue.





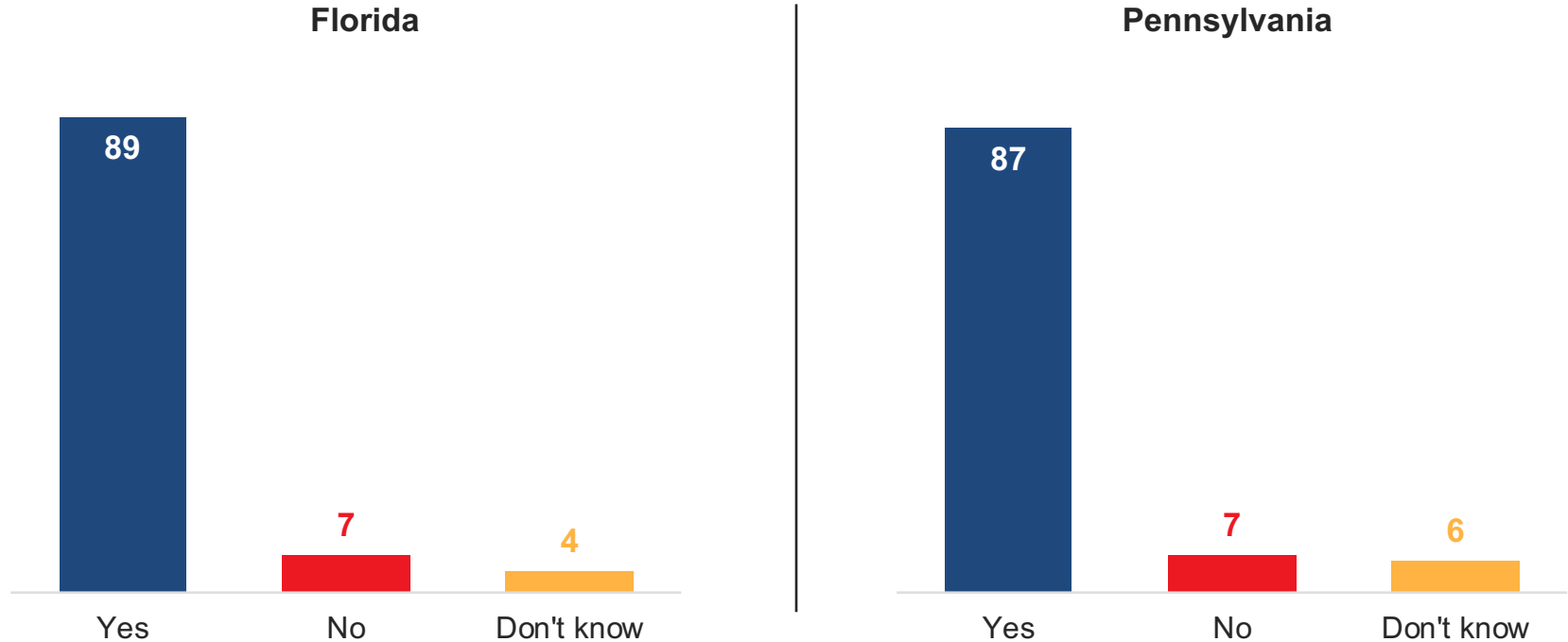

People often talk about being "pro-Israel." Do you think someone can be critical of Israeli government policies and still be "pro-Israel?"

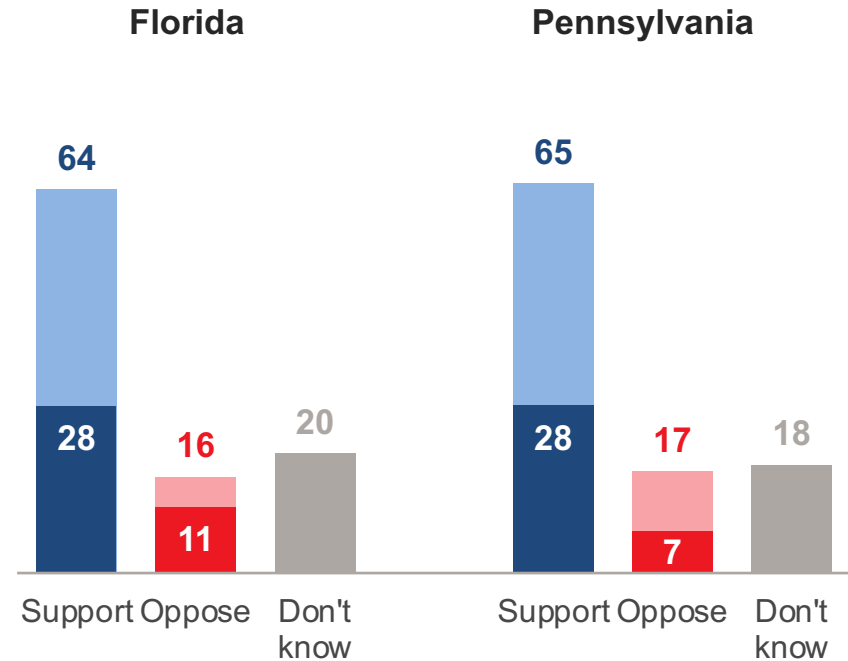


Final Status Agreement

As you may know, on a few occasions during the past several years, Israeli, Palestinian, and American negotiators came close to reaching a final status peace agreement but ultimately fell short.

The details of that agreement include: a demilitarized Palestinian state in the West Bank and Gaza, internationally recognized borders that allow most Jewish settlers in the West Bank to be inside Israel while the Palestinians get comparable land areas in return, Palestinian neighborhoods in Jerusalem become part of the new Palestinian state while Israel retains control of Jewish neighborhoods and the Western Wall in Jerusalem, and a declaration from both sides that the conflict is over and no further claims will be made by either side.

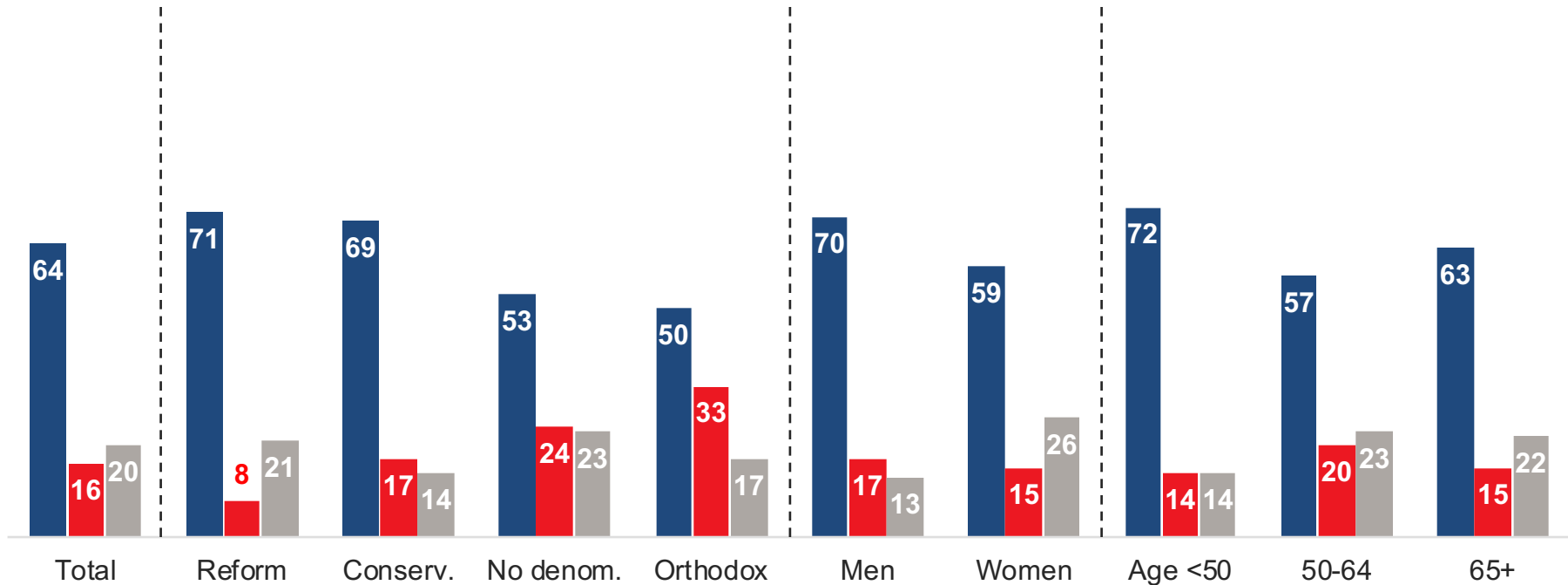


Support For 2-State Agreement Spans Jewish Electorate In FL

● Support ● Oppose ● Don't know

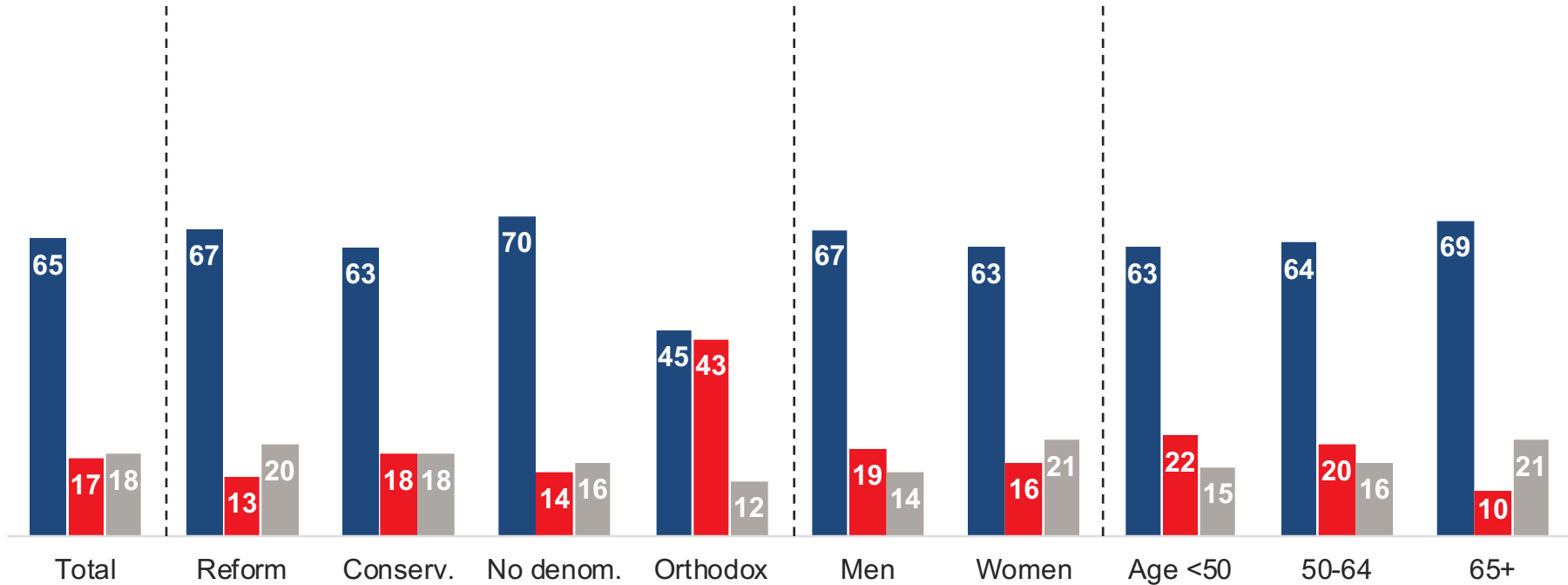


PA Also Has Broad Support For 2-State Agreement

Strong Support For Re-entering Iran Agreement

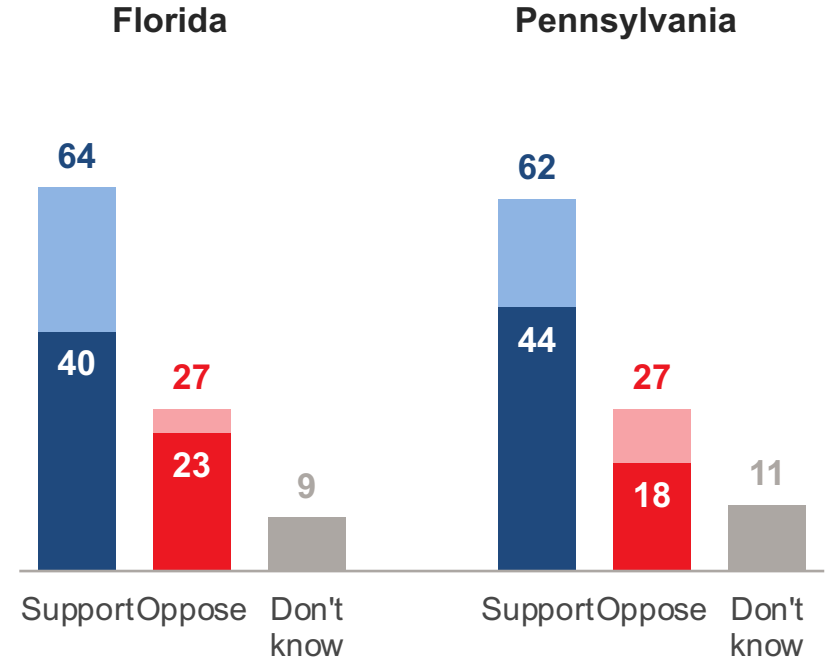
