Q.29 As you may know, on a few occasions during the past several years, Israeli, Palestinian, and American negotiators came close to reaching a final status peace agreement but ultimately fell short.

The details of that agreement include: a demilitarized Palestinian state in the West Bank and Gaza, internationally recognized borders that allow most Jewish settlers in the West Bank to be inside Israel while the Palestinians get comparable land areas in return, Palestinian neighborhoods in Jerusalem become part of the new Palestinian state while Israel retains control of Jewish neighborhoods and the Western Wall in Jerusalem, and a declaration from both sides that the conflict is over and no further claims will be made by either side.
