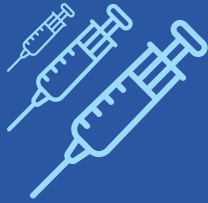


J STREET 2022 NATIONAL CONFERENCE COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Health and safety is our number one priority. J Street may revise its health and safety protocols as circumstances change. If it is unsafe to gather in person, the conference will continue virtually.



All conference participants will be required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and will be required to have received a COVID-19 booster shot. Participants will upload their vaccine information to a secure app in advance of the conference for verification.



We strongly encourage all Conference attendees to wear a mask when you are not actively eating or drinking. Masking is encouraged for the safety of our community.



All participants will be required to complete a health questionnaire prior to entering the event space each day. Those who are experiencing COVID-19 related symptoms will not be admitted. In accordance with CDC guidance, those experiencing symptoms should take a rapid antigen or PCR COVID test.



J Street will work with the event venue to provide enhanced cleaning and sanitizing measures - and to enforce strict capacity maximums for all event spaces.



For those who are unable to attend in person or would prefer to attend remotely, a virtual ticket option is available.
